At Community Concern for Cats, we create miracles both big and small.

While many cat rescue groups focus on pulling cats from municipal shelters, CC4C is unique because we're on the front lines answering calls for help and rescuing cats directly from the community. Every year, we help thousands of friendly abandoned pets and homeless "community cats" who have no one else to care for them.

Last year, over 4000 cats received spay and neuter surgeries or lifesaving medical treatment at our Cat Hospital, and 1,100 friendly foster cats found loving homes through our adoption program!

Our Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program helps community cats who aren't candidates for adoption. Many arrive sick or injured and depend on us for medical care and compassion. Through this program, we reduce suffering and overpopulation, giving each cat a second chance at a healthier, safer life. When we find friendly cats through TNR, we bring them into our foster program so they can find the safe, loving homes they deserve.



Since our founding in 1986, our all-volunteer team has worked tirelessly to save as many cats as we can. In recent years, as veterinary costs have soared, a record number of sick and injured cats have needed our help. **For the past two years we've faced a \$200,000 shortfall as we continue working to save as many cats as we can. That's why your support right now matters more than ever!**

A Miracle in the Making: From Suffering to Loved

Earlier this year, CC4C faced one of the most extreme rescue situations in our 36-year history. A neglected property had become a hazardous hoarding site filled with debris and overrun with starving, sick cats. **For ten long months, two of our dedicated trappers, joined by several other volunteers, worked day and night to rescue 107 cats and kittens.**

Each one was brought to our hospital to be neutered, vaccinated and given the intensive medical care needed to survive. Among them were two tiny kittens, Nick and Nora, found barely alive, covered in fleas, and fighting severe infections. After multiple rounds of treatment and weeks of care, they made a full recovery. Their foster family fell in love and adopted them both, giving them the safe, happy home they deserved. Nick and Nora's story is just one of the miracles happening every day and made possible because of people like you.
